

Continuing Education Information

The Certified Radiology Administrator (CRA) Exam Workshop is designed to facilitate the attendees' study and preparation for the CRA Exam. It focuses on areas to study as well as provides references and direction to other resources. Attendees should use the course to identify their respective areas of strength and weakness. This practical, real-life approach is designed to take the fear out of Six Sigma, leaving its attendees empowered to make confident imaging decisions and with a desire to further expand this knowledge through subsequent belts.
